Schedule of Consular Camp in Brisbane 2017

This is to inform that the High Commission will organize a Consular Camp in **Brisbane** from 15–17 September 2017 (Friday- Sunday) at the following schedule and address:

- Mission will be rendering Machine Readable Passport (MRP) service during the consular camp. All who wish to apply for machine Readable Passport at the camp is requested to seek appointment by sending filled-in MRP form (4-pages in PDF format/scanned copy). Appointment will be given through email consular.canberra@mofa.gov.bd only. Last date of request for appointment is 8th September 2017. Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and applicant will be required to be present at the premises with required documents on the appointment date and time. For other services (a.i. NVR, POA, different attestation), no prior appointment is needed. It's first come first serve basis on the stipulated time and date at the camp. - All are requested to be at the camp at least half an hour ahead of the each closing time.
- Copies of all documents will be required to be submitted with application. Originals will be required only for viewing.
- **The High Commission may amend the schedule as and when necessary.** Therefore, it is advised to see the correct schedule at the website of the High Commission at www.bhcanberra.com.

Photocopy of all relevant documents and 02 copies passport size pictures will be required.

Following consular services however will NOT be available at the consular camp:

- Issuance of VISA other than NO VISA required (NVR) seal.
- Driving Licenses verification- all are requested to send the required documents to the High Commission in Canberra by postal mail. Details are given at the website.

Please Note:

- All payments must be made through EFT (MINIMUM 3 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO SERVICE)/ Postal Money Order or Bank Cheque** (not personal cheque) in favour of "Bangladesh High Commission, Canberra" as **we DO NOT accept cash, credit card, eftpos, direct debit or personal cheque.**
- All consular service seekers are requested to kindly have their money order or bank cheque prepared during week days as most post offices and banks are closed on weekends. Fee for consular services of multiple applicants (e.g. members of a family) of different natures separate payment must be paid in different cheque / money order but of similar nature may be combined in one cheque / money order.
