- All, who wish to apply for New / Re-Issue of Machine Readable Passport (MRP) at the camp is requested to seek appointment by sending filled-in MRP form (3-pages in PDF format/scanned copy) at email mrp.canberra@mofa.gov.bd. Please mentioned the subject line of your email as Melbourne Camp-MRP-your first name. Last date of request for appointment is **09 March 2022**. Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and applicant will be required to present at the camp premises with required documents on the appointment date and time.
- All, who wish to apply for NVR at the camp is requested to send a copy (in PDF format/scanned copy) of the online/electronically submitted visa application form along with required documents (proof of nationality, proof of payment etc.) at email consular.canberra@mofa.gov.bd by **09 March 2022**. Please mentioned the subject line of your email as Melbourne Camp-NVR-your first name Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and the applicants will be required to present at the camp

Police Clearance, BRN, POA, different attestations), we encourage the service seekers to seek appointments as well to enable us to hold the consular camp in a COVID safe way maintaining social distancing.
