

Instructions for Reissuance of Passport abroad

(For Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tuvalu and Vanuatu)

Reference: Letter no. 58.00.0000.043.32.007.17(Part).56, dated 08 April 2021, Security Services Division, Ministry of Home Affairs, Bangladesh.

- A. For issuance of passport
- i) Passport will only be issued against an existing passport
 - ii) Permanent Residence Card/ Job ID card/ Student ID card/any photo ID etc. in support of applicant's residence in the foreign country
 - iii) Police report (in case of lost passport)
 - iv) Bangladeshi citizens can however apply for new passport for their newborns. Eligible foreign nationals can apply for new passport provided the applicant is granted citizenship of Bangladesh.
- B. Additional information/documents for changing information in passport
- i) National ID (for adult)
 - ii) Certificate of public examinations (JSC/ JDC/SSC/HSC/Dakhil/ technical/ open university);
or
birth certificate
 - iii) A hand-written application along with a declaration that the applicant will be responsible in case any legal complication arises in relation to this change.
