



## International Student Arrival Plan in Australia as of 26 November

As part of Australia's further steps to reopen its international border, from 1 December 2021 Australia will allow fully vaccinated eligible visa holders to come to Australia without needing to apply for a travel exemption. Under these arrangements, students will be treated as 'Eligible visa holders' to travel to Australia. However, they must:

- Be fully vaccinated with a completed dosage of a vaccine approved or recognised by Australia's Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA)\*
- Hold a valid student visa
- Provide proof of their vaccination status
- Present a negative COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test taken within three days of departure.

Students travelling to Australia are advised to check and comply with the quarantine requirements in the state or territory of their arrival, and any other state or territory to which they plan to travel.

### ACT

### NSW

## Queensland

As per Queensland's COVID-19 Vaccine Plan, there will **still be a requirement to quarantine** before 90% of Queensland's eligible population is fully vaccinated which is now 74%. While students are now allowed to return to Australia without the need for exemptions, their return to Queensland may still be subject to quarantine availability. ## Victoria

Fully vaccinated international students entering **Victoria will not need to quarantine**. They will also be required to test negative to COVID-19 within 72 hours before their departure and undertake testing within 24 hours of arrival in Victoria.

## South Australia

There will be a **requirement to quarantine** for travellers arriving South Australia. Once 90% of South Australians are fully vaccinated which is now 78%, all international travellers who are fully vaccinated will not need to quarantine.

- \* Current approved and recognised vaccines and dosages in Australia are:
- Two doses at least 14 days apart of: AstraZeneca Vaxzevria/AstraZeneca      Covishield/      Pfizer/Biontech Comirnaty/Moderna      Spikevax/Sinovac      Coronavac/      Bharat Biotech Covaxin/ BBIBP-CorV      Sinopharm
  - Or one dose of: Janssen-Cilag COVID Vaccine.
