**Schedule of Consular Camp in New Zealand 2018**

This is to inform that the High Commission will organize a Consular Camp in **AUCKLAND & TAURANGA** from **13-15 July 2018 (Friday, Saturday & Sunday)** at the following schedule and address:

- Mission will be rendering Machine Readable Passport (MRP) service during the consular camp. All, who wish to apply for machine Readable Passport (New & Re-Issue) at the camp are requested to seek appointment by sending filled-in MRP form (in PDF format /scanned copy). Appointment will be given through email [consular.canberra@mofa.gov.bd](mailto:consular.canberra@mofa.gov.bd) only. Last date of request for appointment is 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018. Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and applicant will be required to present at the premises with required documents (Filled-in original form, original passport, NID/Birth ID, proof of payment etc.) on the appointment date and time. For other services (a.i. NVR, POA and different attestations), no prior appointment is needed. It's first come first serve basis on the stipulated time and date at the consular camp.
- All are requested to be at the camp at least half an hour ahead of the each closing time. Copies of all documents will be required to be submitted with application. Originals will be required only for viewing.
- **The High Commission may amend the schedule as and when necessary.** Therefore, it is advised to see the correct schedule at the website of the High Commission at [www.bhcanberra.com](http://www.bhcanberra.com)

**N.B: Student Concession:** Bangladeshi passport holder having student mentioned as profession in their existing passport and currently studying in any Educational Institution in Australia or New Zealand will be eligible for student concession. Please submit copy of your valid Student ID and copy of the Bangladesh passport.

Photocopy of all relevant documents and 02 copies passport size pictures will be required.

**Following consular services however will NOT be available at the consular camp:**

- (a) Issuance of VISA other than NO VISA required (NVR) seal.
- (b) Driving Licenses verification - all are requested to send the required documents to the High Commission in Canberra by postal mail. Details are given at the website.

**Please Note:**

- **All payments must be made through International Bank Draft OR EFT (MINIMUM 3 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO SERVICE)** in favour of "Bangladesh High Commission, Canberra" as we **DO NOT** accept cash, credit card, eftpos, direct deposit or personal cheque.
- All consular service seekers are requested to kindly have their bank draft prepared during week days as most banks and post offices are closed on weekends. Fees for consular services of multiple applicants (e.g. members of a family) of **different natures, separate payment must be paid in different cheque / draft, but of similar nature may be combined in one cheque / draft.**
