General attestation of documents like photocopy of Bangladesh passport, photograph, application for police clearance certificate, applications for opening a bank account in Bangladesh (Each application)	15.00
'No Visa Required....' stamp in Australian/ New Zealand or other eligible citizen (For first time or transfer)	70.00

All concerned are requested to kindly visit the consular Services Section of the Website of the High Commission <http://www.bhcanberra.com> for detailed information regarding different types of consular services, mentioned above. **Photocopy of all relevant documents and 2 copies passport size pictures will be required for all consular services.**

Following consular services however will NOT be available at the consular camp:

- Issuance of VISA other than NO VISA required (NVR) seal;*
- Issuance/Re-Issue of Bangladesh passport;*
- Driving Licenses verification- all are requested to send the required documents to the High Commission in Canberra. Details are given at the website.*



Please Note:

- All payments must be made through Postal Money Order / Bank Cheque or EFT (**MINIMUM 3 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO SERVICE, Please attach a transaction report/receipt with the application**) in favour of "Bangladesh High Commission, Canberra".
- **Cash, credit card, eftpos, personal cheque, direct deposit or Company cheque are not accepted.**
- All consular service seekers are requested to kindly have their money order or bank cheque prepared during week days as most post offices and banks are closed on weekends. Fee for consular services of multiple applicants (e.g. members of a family) of different natures separate payment must be paid in different cheque / money order but of similar nature may be combined in one cheque / money order.

- The High Commission would like to **repeat that cash will NOT be accepted under any circumstances.**
